## *Introduction to Neijing Classical Acupuncture*

The Neijing Classical Acupuncture seminar was designed to offer the practitioner a solid introduction to the key concepts of the principles and practices of classical acupuncture. The intensive twelve-session class is taught exclusively from an extensive collection of original translations of the Huangdi Neijing, Suwen and Lingshu (黃帝內經素問靈樞), which are provided by the instructor. He studied acupuncture for four years with Dr. Anita Cignolini of Milan, Italy, then continued with post-graduate studies in Chinese languages at Portland State University, as well as advanced studies in classical Chinese language at Heilongjiang University in Harbin, China. He is a graduate of the School of Classical Chinese Medicine at the National College of Natural Medicine in Portland, Oregon, where he has also been employed as a full-time faculty member since 2005.
